Developing a repository of best practices and providing expert advice in areas of board responsibilities.

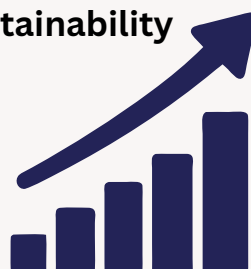
How We Deliver

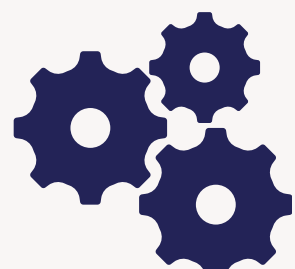
